## INTRODUCTION

...the Alphabet of Thoth can be dimly traced in the modern Tarot which can be had at almost every bookseller in Paris. As for it being understood or utilized, the many fortune-tellers in Paris, who make a professional living by it, are sad specimens of failures of attempts at reading, let alone correctly interpreting the symbolism of the Tarot without a preliminary philosophical study of the Science - Helena Petrovna Blavatsky
On the following pages I present the Taroscopic meanings of the seventy eight Tarot Arcana. The meanings provided have been developed gradually since 1997 when my first Tarot website was launched.
Tarot practitioners soon discover that the meaning of a card changes based on a client's question and level of understanding. Additionally, a card's meaning changes based on the spread position on which it appears, and if and when it appears in an inverted or reversed position in a spread.
In the Taroscopic System, card meanings are divided into Upright Positive, Upright Negative and Reversed categories. However, it will become obvious that a reversed card can also have either a positive or a negative connotation depending on the client's question and spread position on which it is placed. In short, a single card can have up to four different interpretations.
In the Taroscopic System, reversed card meanings are considered very important. This is because reversed cards provide us with the information we require to successfully counsel clients. After all, clients do not typically book appointments and come for readings because they wish to hear us explain what they already know is happening to them. They want to know what to do and what to avoid, and to receive valuable advice preventing setbacks, losses, failures, disappointments and danger. They come to receive information about future opportunities, challenges, obstacles and warnings, and to be preinformed about the behavior, decisions, choices and schemes of other people in their professional and personal lives. Generally, reversed cards provide us with the do's and don'ts. Therefore, studying and using reversals takes your interpretative and counseling competence up to a high degree of excellence.
In this book I feature the cards of the Rider-Waite deck. This wonderful deck is perfect for beginners but is also used by experienced readers. Crucially, it is one of the only decks to present the correct astrological order. It was the outcome of the ground-breaking Book T, by Samuel Liddell MacGregor Mathers, head of the Hermetic Order of the Golden Dawn.
The sixteen Court Royals have had their names changed over time. Originally they were known by the titles Knight, Queen, King and Page. Decks with this attribution feature three male cards and one female card. These antiquated titles appear on Rider-Waite Court Royal cards. English occultist Aleister Crowley decided to change the titles in order to balance the genders. His Thoth deck features the titles Knight, Queen, Prince and

Princess. Given that the esoteric name of God - IHVH (Yod, He, Vau, He) - features two male letters (Yod and Vau), and two female letters (He and He), we see that Crowley's changes were correct. Bear this in mind when using the Rider-Waite deck which features the older attributions.
The Court Royals have been much misunderstood. They are to be considered a separate deck in themselves. Although they certainly represent individual types in the world around us, they also represent the personality traits of a single individual. In other words, all sixteen Court Royal cards represent a single person. Entire readings can be given using only these sixteen cards.
On Aleister Crowley's marvellous Thoth deck, we find that cards 8 and 11 have been reversed, with one occupying the position of the other. Crowley's reasons for changing the numbers and astrological correspondence of these two cards are not esoterically sound. Therefore, when using the Thoth deck, the two cards should be restored to their correct place in the Major Arcana, to once again correspond with the correct astrological order attributed to them by MacGregor Mathers. In this case, Arcanum 8 (entitled Strength or Lust) corresponds with the sign of Leo, while Arcanum 11 (entitled Justice or Adjustment) corresponds with the sign of Libra. With this change the Thoth Tarot becomes the single greatest and most powerful deck in existence.
Allow me to remind readers that the ancient Tarot was not created by Gypsies; is not expressly for the use of bat-crazy fortune-tellers, or merely a pastime for those who enjoy card games. On the contrary, Tarot is the heart of the Western Magical Tradition. It is the means by which we enter into direct dialogue with our "Inner Zodiac" or "Living Oracle." Tarot also provides the "glue" which connects the ancient Hermetic Arts of Divination Astrology, Kabala and Numerology.
In this book I do not mention Tarot spreads. In my Taroscopic System - and online Taroscopic Mystery School - various dynamic spreads are employed, such as the Four Card Spread, Kabalistic Spread, Relationship Spread and Astrological Spread.
